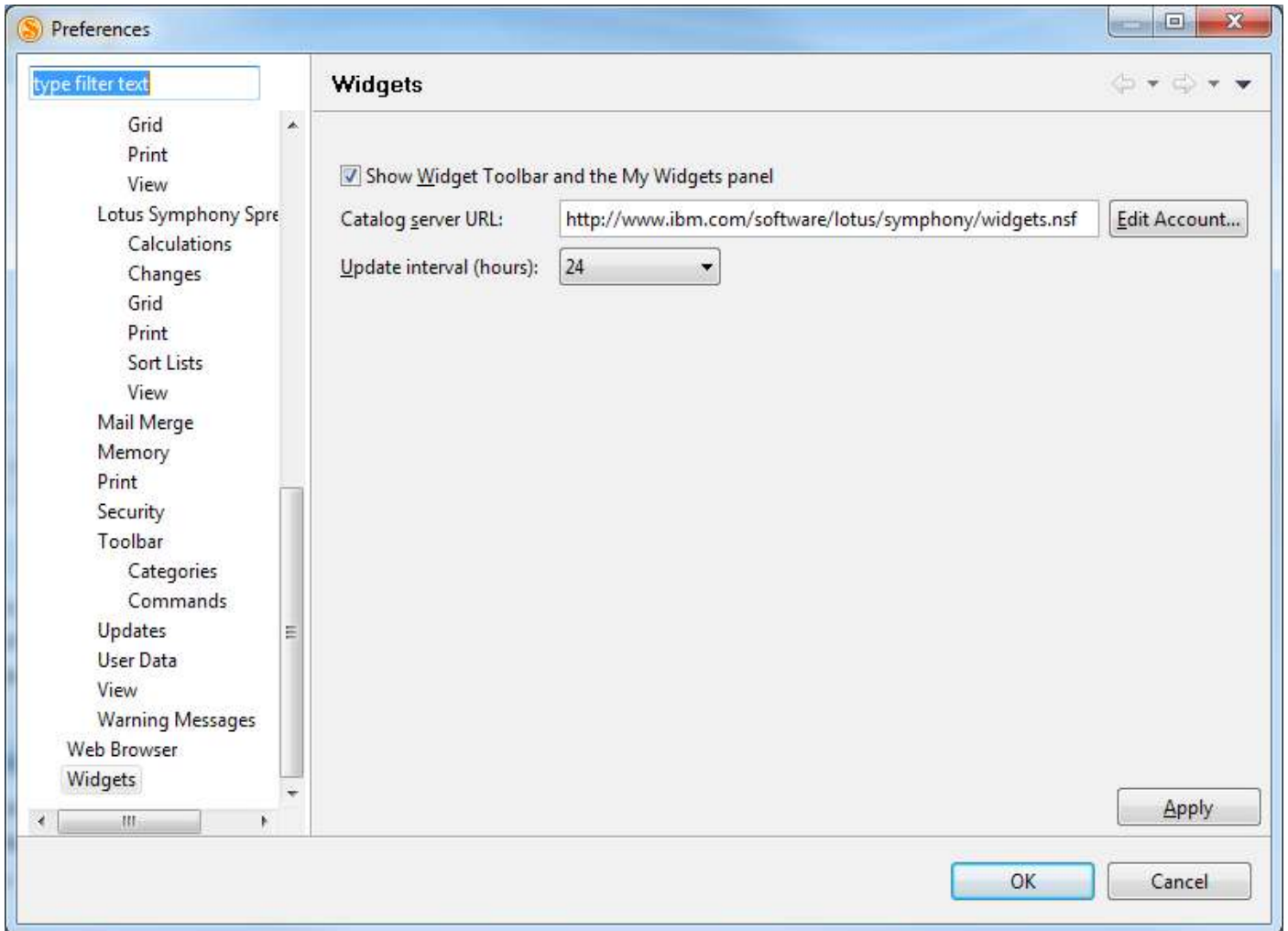
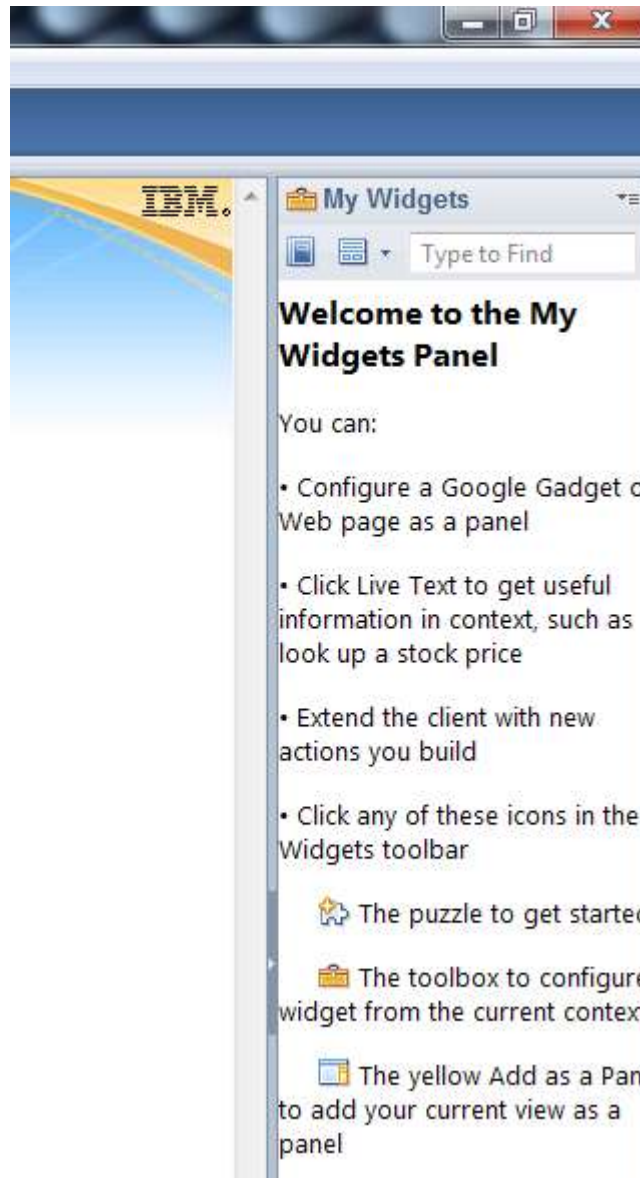


How to install and uninstall an EuroSymphony extension

First you have to enable Lotus Symphony's *My widgets* sidebar.



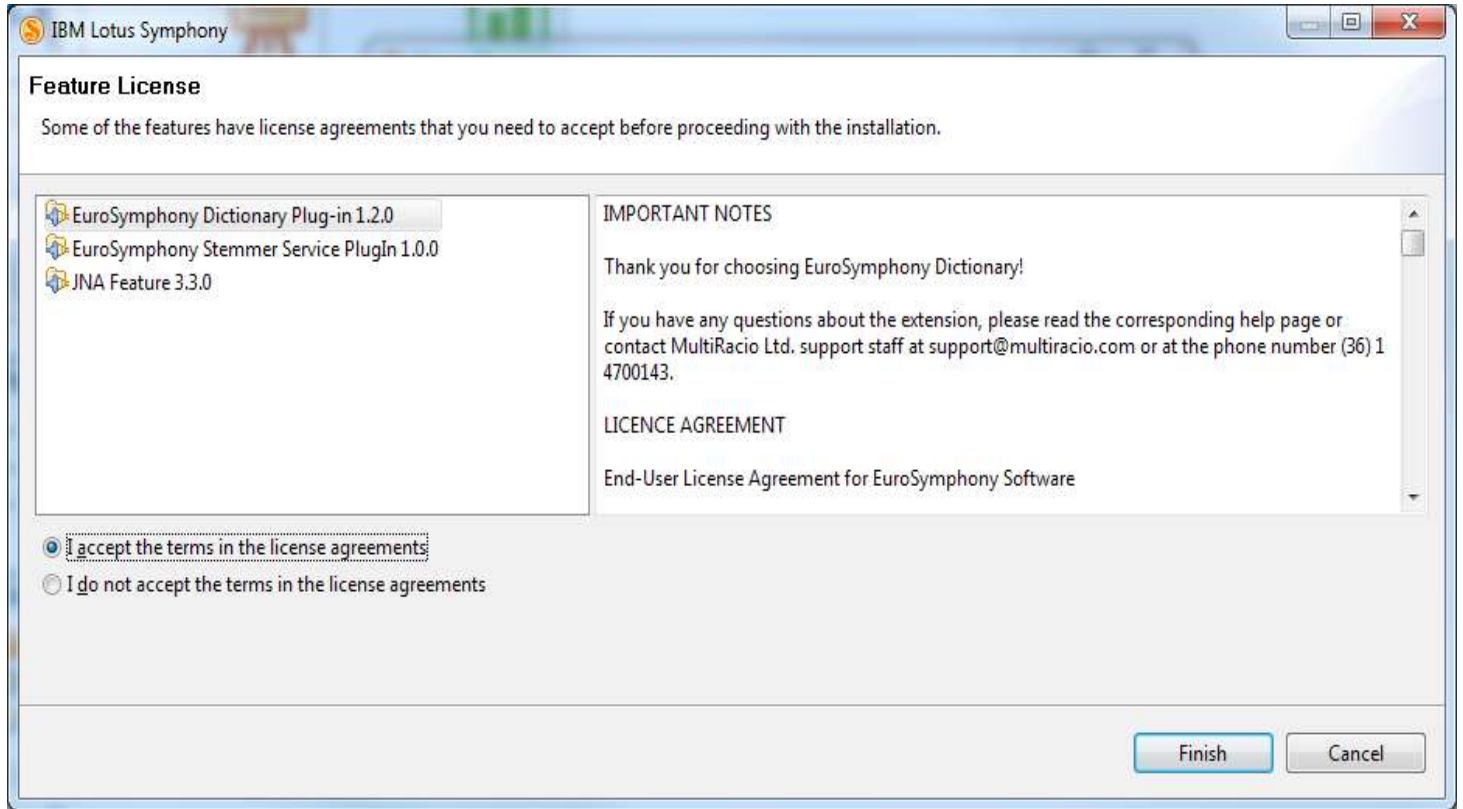
You can do that in *File – Preferences*. At the bottom of page you can find *Widgets*. Check *Show Widget Toolbar and the My Widgets Sidebar panel*, then click OK. After that My Widgets icon will appear in Symphony window. You can open it with a simple click.



You have to drag & drop the extension's installer to the sidebar.

EuroSymphony extensions installers are simple .zip files. After downloading a .zip installer, open the folder that contains it (e.g. with Windows Explorer), then drag & drop this file to Lotus Symphony's *My Widgets* sidebar for starting installation.

If everything is OK, then installation will be starting. You have to read and accept its license agreement.



Some extensions have two installer packages (e.g. JNA Feature is an EuroSymphony Dictionary dependency), then you have to accept both license agreements to continue installation. It will be finished with closing and reopening Lotus Symphony application. Installation is successful, if you can see Dictionary's sidebar on My Widgets.



Installed extension's icon will appear on *My Widgets*, so you can start its removing here. Choose *Remove* from its pop-up menu for uninstalling this extension from your system.
