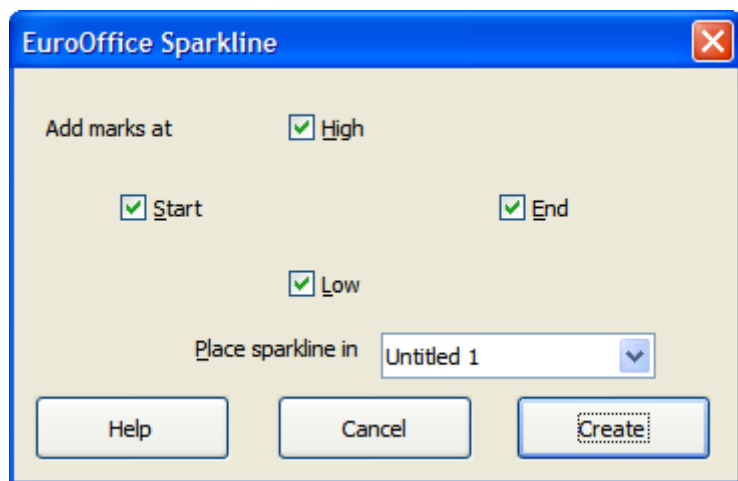





EuroOffice Sparkline


EuroOffice Sparkline is an OpenOffice.org Calc extension by MultiRacio Ltd. Sparklines are small (word-size) charts that illustrate trends and variations.

To create a sparkline from a data series select it in Calc and click EuroOffice Sparkline in the Insert menu.



Sparklines can be augmented with small dots that mark the start and end of the line and high or low points of the line. These dots are conventionally colored red for the start and end and blue for the maximum and minimum values. These colors help you associate numerical information with the data points as in the example below:

Sparklines are also useful for integration in text. For example I could mention here that our fictional currency appears to exhibit a periodic dependency on the USD and its current value can be expected to increase after a few more months ( -3.138).

Once the sparkline has been created it can easily be placed in any document by cutting and pasting it.
